Headteacher update from Faye Calder-Kelly

Welcome back!

I hope you all had a relaxing Easter break. The summer term will see school begin to return to pre Covid times, but we are asked to still remain cautious. The updated guidance for schools comes into effect and this will allow us to make some changes to our infection control mitigations.

There are no longer any restrictions on gatherings within school and as such we are able to hold assemblies and school events. We will also be able to begin to welcome parents/carers back into the school building. This will be a gradual process and I have attached a copy of our 'diary dates for the Summer Term' which outlines some opportunities for parents to attend school events.

National guidance is that we will no longer be expecting children and staff to undertake asymptomatic testing and we will no longer send home warn and inform letters to parents following confirmed positive cases. **As always if your child is unwell, whatever it might be, please keep them at home until they are well enough to be back in school.** This keeps everyone safe from the spread of possible infections.

School Day Times and Drop Off/Pick Up Arrangements

The decision has been made to keep our school times as they are for the rest of this school year. They will change from August 2022. Further information regarding this will be shared later in the term.

All parents/carers are now welcome to come into the school grounds and face coverings are no longer mandatory. However, we would ask that parents/carers use caution and remain distanced where possible. Parents/Carers may be asked to wear face coverings when entering the school building but this will be reviewed.
