PRIMARY 5 CLASS NEWSLETTER – TERM 1 2023-2024 HERMITAGE PARK PRIMARY SCHOOL

In LITERACY this term we are learning -

- Spelling using new sounds Hermitage Park spelling progression focussing on a new sound fortnightly. Revise a variety of spelling skills.
- To develop our grammar awareness revision of nouns, verbs, and adjectives.
- To use appropriate punctuation, including commas, question marks, exclamation marks and paragraphs.
- Focus on personal and persuasive writing.
- Reading Comprehension skills linked to group and class novels. To choose a variety of books to read for enjoyment from class and school library.
- Further develop listening and talking skills through the Mock Court programme.

In NUMERACY AND MATHEMATICS this term we are learning –

- Maths- symmetry, area and capacity
- Understanding right angle turns and compass directions.
- Hermie Counts- counting forwards and backwards in multiples of 2 10.
- Numeracy- to increase fluency and accuracy of number bonds and table facts.
- Numeracy-Place value
- Continue to revise basic fractions and comparing these

In HEALTH AND WELLBEING we will be learning-

- P5 will have PE on a Tuesday and Thursday. The children will be learning invasion games. Please ensure your child has a full PE kit in class.
- Our Building Resilience theme will be to 'Take a Moment'. We will be learning strategies to support times when our emotions are up and down.
- We will be continuing to discuss the 'Four Zones of Regulation' which will equip us with the tools needed to understand, communicate and manage our emotions

Our TOPIC is a Novel Study along with Junior MockCourt-

- We will be reading the novel Malamander and completing activities based on this.
- We will link our novel to art and drama activities – character study and improvisation.
- The Junior Mock Court is a crosscurricular project which uses a court case to encompass a range of class room subjects - from art to journalism, and debating to writing skills.
