### PRIMARY P5 CLASS NEWSLETTER – TERM 2 2023 HERMITAGE PARK PRIMARY SCHOOL

#### In LITERACY this term we are learning -

- Spelling using new sounds Hermitage Park spelling progression focussing on a new sound fortnightly. Revise a variety of spelling skills.
- To develop our grammar awareness use of adverbs to talk about time, place, and cause. Use of heading and subheadings in non-fiction texts. Use the present tense and past tense in the correct way.
- To use appropriate punctuation, including full stops and capital letters, use of paragraphs in a text.
- Focus on imaginative writing -descriptive settings and developing persuasive writing skills.
- Reading Comprehension skills linked to group and class novels. To choose a variety of books to read for enjoyment from class and school.

## In NUMERACY AND MATHEMATICS this term we are learning –

- Maths- managing money, comparing costs and understanding the importance of budgets.
- Hermie Counts- Using on and back strategy in 1s, 2s, 5s, 10s and halves.
- Numeracy- Multiplication and division in multiples of 10 and beyond. Using these within word problems.
- Continued consolidation of understanding in Place value- units, tens, hundreds, thousands and beyond.

## In HEALTH AND WELLBEING we will be learning:

- P5 will have PE on Wednesday. Please ensure your child has a full PE kit in class.
- Our Building Resilience theme will be 'Talk Things Over'. This will focus on the
  importance of knowing who to talk to if
  you have any worries or problems.
