In LITERACY this term we are learning -

- Spelling using new sounds Hermitage Park spelling progression focussing on a new sound weekly. Revise a variety of spelling skills.
- To develop our grammar awareness revision of adjectives to make writing more interesting.
- To use appropriate punctuation, including commas, apostrophes and paragraphs when writing.
- A focus on functional writing information leaflets and persuasive argument writing.

- Maths- we will be finishing off money and finance.

- Hermie counts number recognition and ordering numbers beyond 1000.
- Continue to revise and consolidate division skills.
 - Numeracy- Place value beyond 5 digits

In HEALTH AND WELLBEING we will be learning-

- P5 will have PE on a Tuesday and Thursday.
 The children will be learning gymnastics.
 Please ensure your child has a full PE kit in class.
- Our Building Resilience theme will be to 'Get Active'. We will be learning and understanding how keeping physically well also helps to contribute to our mental health.
- We will be taking part in circle time discussions with focuses such as friendship, building positive relationships, equality, and kindness.
